
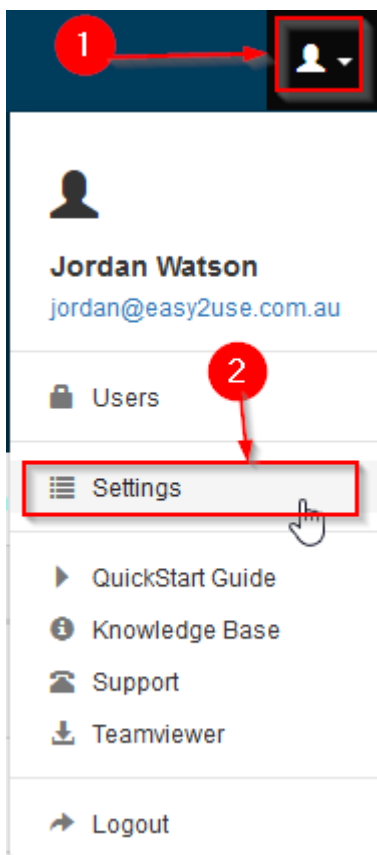



To add or edit Vehicle Groups and Sub Groups, click on your username at the top-right of the screen (1) and then click Settings (2):
